

Working over a small fire is plenty of heat for making bullets

A ladle or pot can be used to melt lead



We used a smaller ladle to aid in pour lead into the mold



Lead is poured into the mold, this mold makes two bullets at a time.



The bullets must be cooled before handling.

Shows bullets before being released from the mold



A finished bullet, note top where lead was poured into the mold – called the sprue. Also note a small line where the mold came together.



A perfectly round bullet will be more accurate. Carrying them in a bullet bag allows the balls to ride against each other and will help erase the sprue and the mold lines.
